

Plant Fitter

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Check all machinery that comes and goes out to site.
- Complete pre-hire inspection sheets and distribute out with the relevant machinery.
- Carry out post-hire inspections, recording any damages / faults that are identified and pass information on as required.
- Review maintenance sheets and record faults as well as help to plan repairs.
- Service and repair machines and equipment, including replacing parts and checking and calibrating instruments.
- Conduct inspections and perform routine servicing and maintenance to equipment, as well as carry out repairs.
- Respond to breakdowns as required and liaise with the internal functions to support in ensuring a successful introduction and implementation of new / purchased production equipment.
- Reduce reactive maintenance where possible by utilising and updating the relevant systems.
- Update fleet hours and servicing data on dashboards and systems.
- Maintain records for all rigs in line with STEQ processes
